EXPEDITED LICENSURE PROCESS FOR INTERNATIONAL NURSES

In the Spring of 2023, NSCN implemented two expedited registration and licensure processes, establishing a fast and predictable pathway to licensure in Nova Scotia for registered nurses who demonstrate good standing and good character and are licensed elsewhere in Canada, or the Philippines, India, Nigeria, USA, UK, Australia, or New Zealand. This report reflects data since November 1, 2023, the start of our 2023-2024 licensure year, and onwards.

Why have the reporting categories changed?

The 'on hold' category has been added to more accurately reflect the status of the applications in our system. Applications are moved into the on-hold status if the applicant has not been engaged³ with NSCN in more than three months.

¹ On hold applications are those where an applicant has not engaged with NSCN in the last three months.

² Active applications in progress are applications where an applicant has been advised of gaps in their application form or we are waiting for the applicant to submit outstanding documents. These applicants have engaged with NSCN within the last three months.

^{3.} Engaged means an applicant has responded to our request to submit additional documents, answer our questions about their application or update their application form.
