To pose a question, participants can type their question(s) into the chat forum via Zoom and a moderator will read the question so that all participants can hear the question and response.

Participants can pose as many questions as they like at any point during the Annual Meeting to be addressed during the Discussion Period. The Chair will attempt to answer at least one question from each individual in the time allotted that has not already been answered.

If there are questions that have not been answered at the end of the allotted time, these questions will be addressed in a post-meeting Q&A resource and made available on the NSCN website.

Please note that mics will be muted for all meeting participants to reduce the risk of unintended disruptions.
